Scientific activity

Since 1982 my scientific interest is closely related to diabetic neuropathy. Beside diabetic patients I have examined autonomic and sensory nerve function in chronic alcoholics as well as in patients with chronic liver diseases. As far as I know, I have firstly described autonomic neuropathy in chronic alcoholic and non-alcoholic liver diseases. I have edited a book, titled "Neuropathies" published by Springer Verlag on Hungarian (1996, 2002) and English language (1997, 2002). I have written chapters of 14 different books, **162 articles**, a lot of them in journals with higher impact factors (Lancet, Br Med J, Diabetologia, Diabetes Care, Diabetic Medicine, J Hepatol., Z Gastroenterol.). I have presented **411 lectures and/or posters** on various congresses. Moreover, in the last 5 years, I have held **more than 600 educational and/or invited lectures /among them, more than 60 in different countries at various international congresses and meetings**/ on diabetic macro- and microvascular complications (mainly neuropathy) at scientific meetings, congresses, symposiums and in different university departments and hospitals. Another 25 publications were written in journals of patient organisations and associations.
